When to use a *full* kaizen event versus a *point* kaizen event? The golden rule of point kaizen events is...

### ***No homework list!***

Point kaizens are supposed to be implementation focused activities where the solution is already fairly well known. We use a small team of people to accomplish a series of tasks quickly, with the benefit of multiple perspectives provided by various team members.

An example would be a small 5-S team where organization, employee training, and auditing procedures are all completed during the event. Or developing standard work for a process similar to one that already has standard work. Again, training and audit procedure would be completed during the event.
